EVENT DATES

The 2025 All Africa Ultimate Championship (AAUC) will take place over four days, from Thursday, 9 October to Sunday, 12 October 2025.

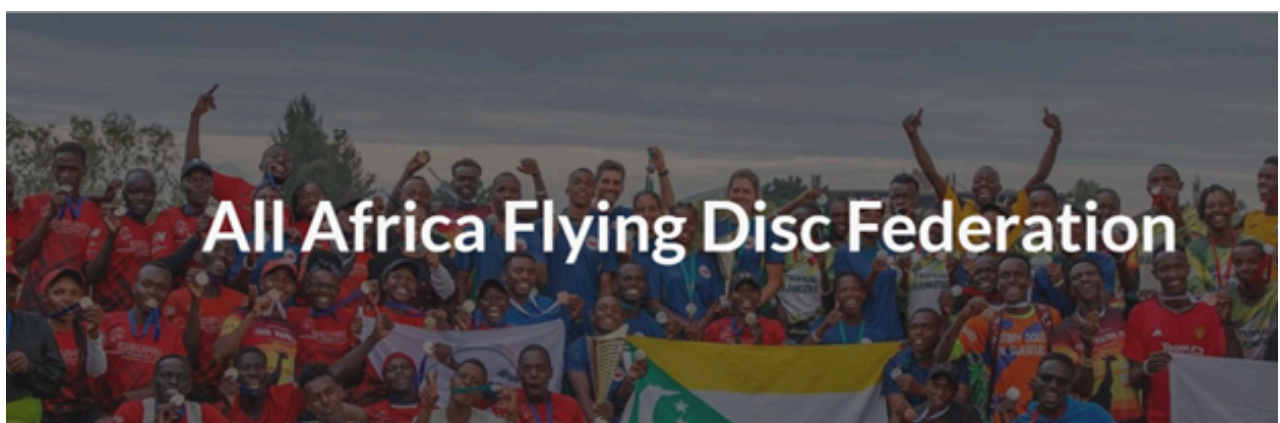
Teams should plan to arrive in Kampala at least one day in advance to ensure timely participation in pre-event briefings and opening day activities. Additional information about team check-in, player briefings, field access for warm-ups, and the full daily competition schedule will be shared following the close of team registration.

All games will be played on natural grass fields at Kampala International School Uganda (KISU), with schedules designed to ensure fair rest and gameplay balance across all competing teams. Please avoid booking return travel before the final day of competition, as games may run until late on Sunday, 12 October.

The All Africa Flying Disc Federation (AAFDF) is the continental governing body of Flying Disc Sports in Africa, recognized by the World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF).

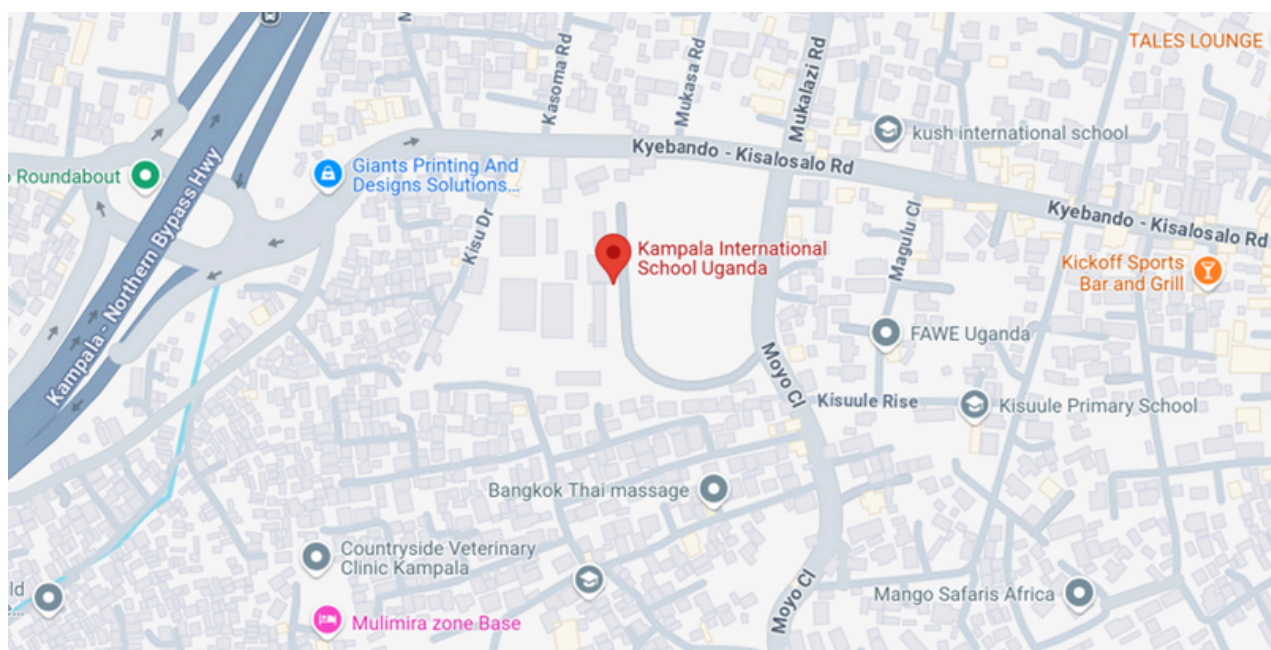
LOCATION AND VENUE MAP

Welcome to Uganda, known as the “Pearl of Africa”—a country where natural beauty, rich heritage, and warm hospitality come together. As the proud host of AAUC 2025, Uganda offers a unique experience for all participants, combining high-level sport with unforgettable cultural discovery.

The championship will take place in Kampala, Uganda’s lively capital. Beyond the playing fields, Kampala is a city full of history and rhythm. You’ll find landmarks such as the Kasubi Tombs, Bahai Temple, Gaddafi Mosque, and the Uganda Museum, as well as vibrant expressions of local music, dance, and art. A visit to the Ndere Cultural Center is highly recommended for those looking to experience Uganda’s cultural heartbeat.

All games will be played at [Kampala International School Uganda](#) (KISU), located at Plot 447 Kyebando - Kisalosallo Road. The fields are well-maintained and suitable for Ultimate Frisbee, with space for four games to be played simultaneously on natural grass.

Teams can reach the venue using local taxis, private vehicles, or ride-hailing apps such as Uber and SafeBoda. These services are widely used in Kampala and offer convenient pickup from any location.

IMPORTANT TRAVEL NOTICE: While motorcycles (boda bodas) are a common form of transport in Uganda, they are not recommended for tournament participants due to **high accident risk** and occasional reports of theft. Please prioritize safety when planning your daily travel.

CLIMATE

Uganda enjoys a tropical climate with two main seasons: wet and dry. In October, Kampala typically experiences warm daytime temperatures averaging around 25°C (77°F), with occasional rain showers.

While the weather is generally pleasant for outdoor play, we recommend that all participants come prepared for both sun and rain. Please bring a hat, sunscreen, umbrella, and raincoat to stay comfortable throughout the tournament days. Hydration and sun protection are essential, especially during long playing hours on the fields.

AIRPORT AND TRANSPORT

IMPORTANT: Please do not book flights or make travel arrangements until your team's participation has been officially confirmed by WFDF to avoid unnecessary costs.

The recommended point of entry for international teams attending AAUC 2025 is [Entebbe International Airport \(EBB\)](#), located approximately 45 km from Kampala. This is Uganda's main international gateway and is served by several major airlines.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION TO KAMPALA



From the airport, teams have several options for reaching the host city and the tournament venue at KISU:

- **Airport Taxi:** Standard airport taxis are available directly outside the arrivals area.
- **Pineapple Express:** A reliable private transport company offering airport transfers.
- **Uber:** Ride-hailing services such as Uber operate in both Entebbe and Kampala.
- **Team Shuttle:** Teams can arrange a group pick-up with the Local Organizing Committee (LOC). If you'd prefer this option, please contact the LOC in advance at ugandaultimate15@gmail.com to schedule your team's transfer from the airport or a central bus terminal.

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS & HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- A **Yellow Fever vaccination** certificate is required for entry.
- Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond your planned departure date.

ACCOMMODATION & BOOKINGS

A variety of accommodation options are available near the tournament venue to suit different team needs and budgets. Teams are encouraged to choose lodging based on proximity, pricing, and availability.

All the options listed below are within a short drive of Kampala International School Uganda (KISU):

- [Bukoto Heights Apartments](#) – approx. 2-minute drive to the fields
- [Forest Cottages](#) – approx. 5-minute drive to the fields
- [Excelsis Garden Hotel Kampala](#) – approx. 7-minute drive to the fields
- [Hillside Plaza Hotel](#) – approx. 7-minute drive to the fields
- [Bushpig Backpackers Hostel](#) – approx. 8-minute drive to the fields

Participants may also explore Airbnb and homestay options in the Bukoto and Ntinda neighborhoods, which are well-connected to the venue.

IMPORTANT: Teams are strongly advised not to make final accommodation bookings until their participation has been officially confirmed by WFDF.



FOOD

The Local Organizing Committee is coordinating with food vendors to offer a variety of on-site meal options during the event. Details about available food stalls, menus, and meal times will be shared closer to the tournament.

Teams are welcome to bring their own snacks and drinks to the venue; however, please note that certain restrictions may apply, particularly regarding outside catering or large group setups. More guidance on permitted items will be provided ahead of the event.

For meals outside of tournament hours, Kampala offers a wide selection of restaurants, supermarkets, and cafes within a short drive from the venue.

HEALTH & MEDICAL

All event participants (athletes, coaches and team support) are recommended to obtain travel insurance prior to booking flights and health insurance before leaving your home country. WFDF and the LOC do not provide coverage for participants outside of the general first aid administered at the fields. There are always risks associated with playing Flying Disc sports and travelling. Although AAUC will have medical staff on site to deal with first aid and assess critical injuries, there may be injuries or illness in which players need follow up medical attention or emergency visits to local hospitals.

WFDF and the LOC kindly request that all players and event participants acknowledge these risks and understand that WFDF and the LOC cannot be held liable for any risk or cost associated with injury or bad health at AAUC. All event participants should alleviate some personal financial liability by purchasing your own travel and health insurance to make sure you are covered for any medical issues or event/travel cancellations that could arise. Participants will be required to sign an Event Participant Agreement published in advance of the event.



VISAS

Once the event bid list is published and your team has been officially registered, we encourage every team and player to make timely and specific enquiries about obtaining a visa to enter Uganda for the WFDF 2025 All Africa Ultimate Championship.

While WFDF cannot offer individual guidance on country-specific visa procedures, we understand how important it is to have the right documentation in place. To support this, WFDF will issue an official letter addressed to the National Federation, confirming that their team is registered for the tournament.

Please note that WFDF does not issue individual visa support letters. Instead, it is the responsibility of each National Federation to provide players, coaches, and team personnel with the appropriate documentation confirming their participation. National Federations are welcome to attach the WFDF team confirmation letter to verify that the individuals listed are officially included in their delegation.

We recommend that every team begins this process as early as possible and works closely with their National Federation to ensure that all participants have the correct paperwork.

AS A REMINDER:

- All **passports** should be valid for at least **six (6) months** beyond your planned travel dates.
- A valid **Yellow Fever vaccination certificate** is required for entry into Uganda.
- Please contact your nearest Ugandan embassy or consulate for the most accurate and up-to-date visa requirements based on your nationality.



UNIFORMS

All teams are required to bring their own playing uniforms and must have two clearly contrasting options—one light and one dark—available at all times during the tournament. This ensures smooth coordination between teams and avoids any color conflicts during matches.

For teams that need assistance obtaining jerseys or wish to order event-specific apparel, the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is happy to support with arrangements. Uniforms can be provided at an additional cost.

FEES & EVENT DEADLINES

DESCRIPTION	FEE	DETAILS
Team Fee	\$100 USD	Non-refundable, Required to confirm team registration.
Player Fee – Non-Student	\$30 USD	Includes event accreditation, access to fields, meetings, player zones, parties, event gift, and awards.
Player Fee – Student	\$20 USD	Same benefits as above. Proof of student status may be required.
Non-Playing Team Support	\$20 USD	For coaches, medics, team admins, or guests. Grants access to the venue but does not permit playing.
Spectators	\$5 USD	General access only. Does not include accreditation or participation in event-specific activities.
Volunteers	FREE	A volunteer application link will be shared after team registration is complete.

- Team fees, Players fees, Non-Playing Team Support and spectator fees are not refundable.
- Player fees may be transferred to another player under certain conditions (e.g., medical reasons. A medical certificate may be required).

CANCELLATION POLICY

Be advised that the event may be forced to cancel by governmental orders or may be perceived to be unsafe and cancelled by the organisers. The organisers may be forced into a last-minute cancellation due to events beyond their reasonable control. If the organisers are unable or unwilling to host the event or any specific participants at the event for reasons beyond their reasonable control, the event may be rescheduled, if possible. If a reschedule is not reasonably feasible, participants, teams and spectators may be unable to recoup any costs already expended for the cancelled event. Each team/participant is strongly encouraged to consider purchasing insurance to cover the costs (travel/accommodations/etc.) as a result of any cancellation or rescheduling of the event by governmental authorities, the organisers, or others.
