## **Beach Ultimate**

Beach Ultimate is a fast growing and exciting sport. Teams of 5 players try to score points by receiving the flying disc (frisbee) in the endzone of the opponent (similar to American Football).

## Movement of the disc and the players


The disc can be thrown from one player to another in any direction, A player may not run with the disc in hand. The person with the disc in hand has 10 seconds to throw the disc to a teammate.

## Change of possession

A turnover (i.e. defense takes possession of the disc and becomes offense) results whenever one of the following items occur:

- the disc touches the ground (also when first touched by the defense)
- the disc is caught outside the field (line is out)
- the disc is intercepted by an oppos-





#### Scorina

A goal, worth 1 point, is scored when a player throws the disc to a teammate and it is successfully caught in the endzone of the other team. Games are 45 minutes or until a team reaches 13 points

### Plaver substitutions

A player can only be substituted after a score was made and the teams are lining up, or if a player is injured. No other substitutions can take place while the point is in progress.

#### Non-contact

Beach Ultimate is a non-contact sport and when a player initiates contact on another player a foul is committed.

#### Self-Refereeing

All fouls are called by the player(s) involved. When a foul results in loss of possession, the play is stopped and resumed as if possession was not lost. If the player committing the foul disagrees with the foul call, the play is redone.

#### Spirit of the Game

Beach Ultimate is about sportsmanship and fair play. Competitive play is encouraged, but never at the expense of respect between players, adherence to the rules, or the basic joy of play.



## **Important Player information**

## Rules

- WFDF Rules of Beach Ultimate 2019 are in use: http://bit.ly/2019BUrules
- All games are to 13 points or 45 minutes, with half-time at 7 points or 25 minutes
- In the Mixed divisions Gender Ratio Rule A is in effect
- Each team has one 90-second timeout per game
- Halftime cap (+1) occurs after 25 minutes of game time if neither team has reached 7 goals
- Half time is 0 minutes in duration
- Time cap (+1) occurs after 45 minutes of game time if neither team has reached 13 goals
- Teams should clear fields and sideline areas to allow next teams to move in and prepare in a timely manner. Spirit circles, team huddles and the like should be done off the field.

#### **Medical Facilities**

The emergency number in Portugal is 112. Regarding medical assistance, there will be doctors and physiotherapists at the venue as well as an ambulance with two paramedics. All medical staff will be in red shirts. Please refer to the map for the medical facilities

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you feel dizzy, are suffering from dehydration or exhaustion, please seek shade immediately, drink plenty of liquids and consult an on-site medical staff member.
