

All Divisions

- All games shall be to 21 points, win by 2, cap at 25 or 1 hr 30mins, which ever is first, except semi-finals and finals which will have no time limit.
- 2. When time is called, play shall continue until the next point is scored.
- 3. If at this time the game is tied, play shall continue until the next score.
- 4. Each team is permitted 3 time outs per half 2 minutes each.
- 5. Half-time will be 10 minutes and occurs the first time either team reaches 11 points.
- 6. Time-outs and Half-time are not part of the 1hr 30mins playing time.
- 7. Games will start on time. Any team not lined up ready to play at the start time will forfeit one point for each minute, or part of minute they are late. BE WELL ON TIME. Even if the previous game overuns its time, teams must be on time to play their game.
- 8. ALL players should be familiar with the WFDF 1991 Rules of Ultimate. Ignorance is no defence.
- All these arrangements are subject to change by the tournament director and rules committee should circumstances demand (for example a hurricane hitting the tournament).

Registration Instructions

- At present we have only received individual player registrations for France and Switzerland.
 All other teams must forward team lists as soon as possible.
- 2. Registration of all teams will be from 11.00 to 16.00hrs on Sunday 25th August at Conference Reception on the Essex University Campus See enclosed map.
- 3. Only one person per country will register all their teams. This should be the person who knows most about payment.
- 4. The people registering the teams will have to provide the following information:
 - a) An up-to-date list of players & staff in each division
 - b) Dates of birth of all players
 - c) Proof of Nationality requirements if foreign players are in your team (passport stamps/ documents)
 - d) Signature of all players and staff
 - e) Numbers of vegetarians
- 5. We will then issue you with the correct amount of:
 - a) Room keys
 - b) Meal Tickets
 - c) Discs
 - d) Shirts
 - e) Player & Staff cards
 - f) Player registration team sheets for each game
- This will only happen if all tournament fees, late payment fees and bank charges have been met.
