

## TRASH & RECYCLING

The TOC and suppliers have worked hard to create a sustainable environment and have put a recycling waste management process in place. Please use the brown bin for general waste, the green bin for plastics, metal cans, and paper. Bins will be located around all competition and spectator areas on the venue. Teams are requested to clean up all areas after their games and to leave the fields in a tidy manner. Spectators are responsible for their own rubbish and should use the appropriate bins as provided.



## SITE RULES

Facility staff, event staff and security will be checking to make sure people are following the site rules. Those caught in violation of the rules risk being barred from the facility, team/athlete disqualifications, and vehicle towing, in addition to ramifications outside of the event. Thank you for following the site rules!

- All Horses have the right of way
- Drive at 5mph when passing horses
- All traffic on SPC roadways is 15mph
- No driving on fields – only in designated grass areas.
- No dogs allowed.
- All WFDF events are smoke-free. No cigarettes or smoking allowed on site.

## LOST & FOUND

Lost and found will be located at the Information Tent. Any lost or found items should be reported to a volunteer or delivered to the Information Tent immediately. This desk will be staffed at all times during the tournament. Items not claimed will be donated to charity.

Must be 21 years or older to drink alcohol. Everyone must present a valid ID which can be one of the following: Drivers license, passport, or other Government ID. No outside alcohol will be permitted. For alcohol purchases, cash or credit only. No refunds. Please drink responsibly!

## **ACCREDITATION**

ALL registered players, team members, staff, volunteers, media and VIPs will receive an event accreditation attached to an event lanyard. To be eligible to utilize the event services, and to play, you must keep your accreditation on you at all times. Please wear your admission lanyard at all times.

Entrance to the venues and tournament party will be refused to any person noticeably under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or any behavior-modifying substance, and to any person behaving, or considered likely to behave, violently, harmfully or contrary to public order. In relation to all of these matters, the assessment of event staff will be determinative and final. Entrance will also be refused to any person who attempts to bring in prohibited items.



Ultimate relies upon a Spirit of the Game that places the responsibility for fair play on every player.

Spirit of the Game (SOTG) is the mindful behavior practiced by players prior to, during and after a game of Ultimate. It encompasses attitudes and skills such as good knowledge and application of the rules, fair-mindedness, safe play and spatial awareness, clear and calm communication, and a positive and respectful attitude towards teammates, fans, and opponents, in a mutual effort to protect the basic joy of play.

We strongly believe that Spirit of the Game helps people to improve their skills in polite, calm and respectful communication even in difficult situations and to make friends all over the world despite ethnic, national or religious differences. Spirit promotes understanding and peace in our sport, and we hope that through you players, that influence can even spread beyond and make real changes in the outside world.

At PAUC, every team in every division has chosen a Spirit Captain. It is this player's responsibility to work with their team and all opposition teams to ensure that the highest standard of the Spirit of the Game is maintained throughout the competition (both on and off the field).

A spirit scoring system has been developed to evaluate the other team immediately after each game. With all players involved and led by the spirit captain, each team fills in a spirit score sheet. Using guidelines found in the spirit scoring examples document, each team can provide a more consistent score for the other team. The spirit scoring system therefore serves as an educational tool where teams can learn how to improve based on standardized feedback.

To celebrate Spirit of the Game, an award will be presented to the team with the highest total spirit score in each division. Winning this award is held in the highest regard and all teams strive to achieve this.

Good luck to all at the WFDF 2019 Pan American Ultimate Championships. Athletes, your ability represents the pinnacle of our sport in your age group and you have the opportunity to demonstrate the highest values of our sport through the Spirit of the Game. Fans and spectators, you can look forward to some incredible action and even more incredible displays of spirit throughout the Championships.



## ANTI-DOPING MESSAGE

The World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF) requires ALL athletes and coaches/medical staff competing in the WFDF 2019 Pan American Ultimate Championships (PAUC) in Sarasota to complete the Real Winner education course prior to the event.

The “Real Winner” educational anti-doping online tool can be accessed under the following link: <http://wfdf.realwinner.org>

Real Winner is an internet based tool which WFDF has used for the past several years. This is an educational exercise and test to enhance the knowledge of Anti-Doping matters for elite athletes and their support personnel concerning subjects such as doping control procedures, the WADA Prohibited List, athletes’ whereabouts reporting and Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE).


