### **DIVISIONS AND COMPETITION**

U20 Mixed: Birth Year 2006 to 2011 U17 Mixed: Birth Year 2009 to 2013

There is space for up to five (5) clubs and one (1) national team from each country, in each division, that have an endorsement from their federation to play in this tournament.

There will be team prizes (medals and trophy) for first, second, third place, and best spirit in each division. There will be individual awards/recognitions for best male and female spirit and male and female MVP in each division.

### TEAM, PLAYER, AND NON-PLAYER REGISTRATION

We will use the Ultimate Central (UC) platform for the registration of teams, players, and non-player/ team staff members.

### Registration Steps:

- 1) Create an Ultimate Central (UC) Account: The team administrator must create an account in UC to register the team for the event.
- 2) Register the team for the Event: Complete the required information:
  - Team name
  - Team image or logo
  - Uniform colors
  - Team administrator information
- 3) Add Players and Non-Players (NPTS) to the Team Roster:
- Players and NPTS who do not yet have an account must create one on UC.
- If players are minors, they must do so through an account created by one of their parents or guardians, who will authorize their participation.
- Only players and NPTS with a registered account may be added to the team roster at the time of initial registration; however, after registering the team, players and NPTS may be added to the roster once they have created their account.

### PAYMENT METHODS

#### **Team Fee**

Direct payment to Ultimate Central (UC): Use a credit or debit card to make the payment. This option has a 3% fee on the total amount.

The fee will be charged on a separate invoice depending on the date you complete the payment.

Transfer with Zelle: Available in the USA, use the email support@breakingborders.org. This option does not generate a fee for transfers made from accounts in the USA. Please let us know if this is your preferred option before sending the money.

Bank Transfer: You can make the payment by direct bank transfer. The fees will apply according to the policies of your bank and the fees for receiving bank transfers at ours.

### Player and Non-Player/Staff Fee

In the first week of March, we will send invoices based on the number of players and NPTS registered to each team on UC.

In case you are not registered on the platform, a minimum of 14 players and 2 NPTS per team will be invoiced.

The invoices will include all the necessary data for payment, along with a link that will allow you to make the payment via credit or debit card, wire transfer, or Zelle (available in the USA).

If you have questions or need clarification, do not hesitate to contact us. We are here to help you!

#### Note:

If you choose options 2 or 3 (Zelle or bank transfer), leave the team registration in UC in the payment step unfinished ("Check Out"). Then, send us an email with the proof of your payment, and we will complete the process manually in UC once the payment is confirmed.

If you have any questions about the registration or payment process with UC please contact us so we can help.

### OFICIAL TRANSPORTATION

We will provide transportation from our partner hotels to and from the fields. In some of the hotels airport transfers are included in the cost of accommodation, but please double check. For any team that is not housed in our tournament hotels, we can offer transportation options that can be purchased directly with the supplier.





### **FOOD**

Breakfast will be included in most partner hotels.

There will be lunch/meal options on the field; Prices should range between \$5 and \$12 per person.

Dinner will be at the discretion of each team.

Depending on where you stay there are excellent local options and most hotels offer your own restaurant service.

During the tournament we will provide hydration, fruit, and some light snacks to keep your energy up!

We will share the tournament menu when we are closer to the event.

### **OFFICIAL HOTELS**

We are still looking for the best possible options for you, which we will continue to share as we receive more options. For now we have confirmed the following accommodations with transportation to and from the fields and breakfast included:

Level 1: \$20-\$35 per night, per person. Level 2: \$35-\$50 per night, per person.

#### **Option 1: Rocco Group**

With this group we have 3 hotels. All are on level 2 (\$35-\$50/person/night), include breakfast, and all offer transportation to and from the airport for an additional fee.

We will have transportation to and from the tournament included for the teams staying here.

We have a block of rooms until the end of April. Please make your reservations with that in mind.



#### Option 2: Alajuela Backpacker Hostel Boutique

This option is at level 1. The cost is \$25 per person and includes transportation to and from the airport and a typical breakfast. The rooms are dormitory style (4, 6, 8, 10 people) and double private with an extra bed (3 people). They all come with A/C, hot water, and a private bathroom, except bedrooms with 8 and 10 people who share a bathroom with each other. The bathrooms will be shared among your team.

Reservations must be made directly with the event organizers and you must notify us if this option interests you. We have a block of rooms until the end of May. Please make your reservations with that in mind.


