

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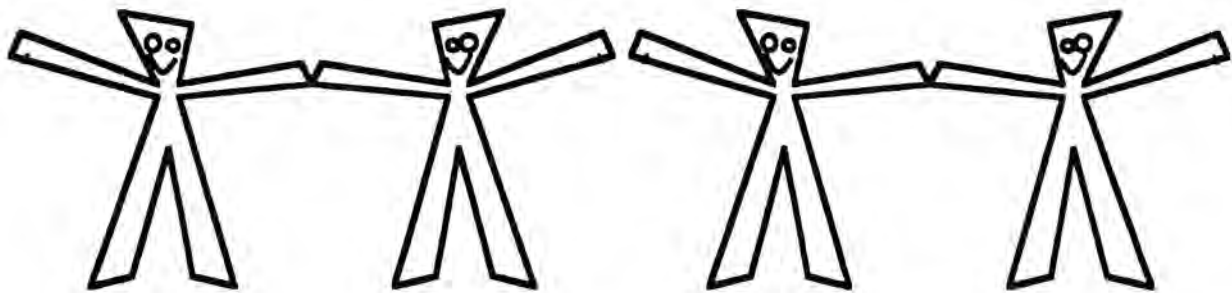

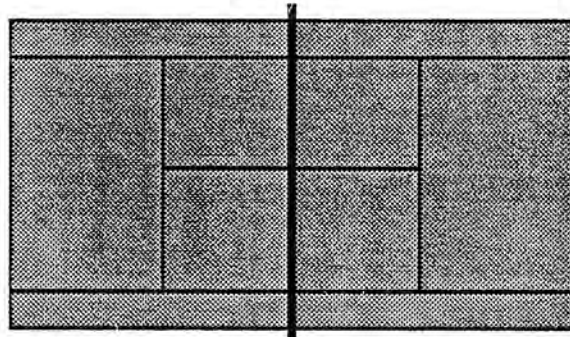

After six years and 45,000 mil's of Ultimate, I look forward to the intensity of another fall season. Ultimate has gone through its' growing pains in the Midwest, but each year the magic of the fall season makes it worthwhile for all of us.

During the course of the last two years there has been rapid improvement in the general level of play in the Central Region and abroad. However, this has coincided with a sharp reduction in the number of teams participating in the Sectional qualifying tournaments. This is a trend that, if unchanged, will have drastic consequences for the sport.

To illustrate, in 1982 there were 16 teams in the Missouri / Iowa Sectional, yet in the 1986 Sectional (now encompassing Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska and Oklahoma) there were a total of eight teams. It is the contention of many participants and observers alike that this is the result of a few teams hoarding players to create teams that can compete on a national level.

Perhaps one way to combat this decline lies in the desire of players to bring new athletes into the game, thereby elevating the overall quality of play while generating a competitive edge. A long term result would be more competitive and less unsolicited "team jumping" by players with high aspirations.

It is the opinion of this player that there has been a decided lack of new players entering the sport on all levels. How can this be? Is this not the sport of the 80's? At best, it may be one of the up and coming sports of the 90's. A negative perspective, you say? No, a realistic one.

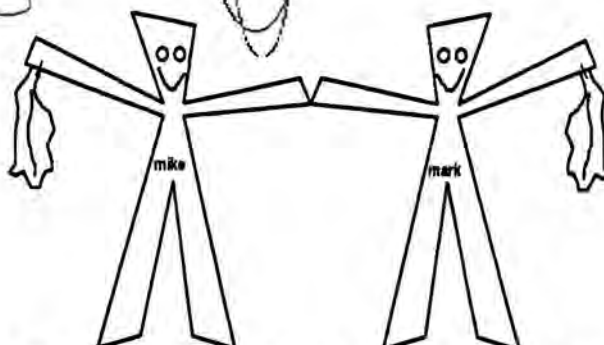
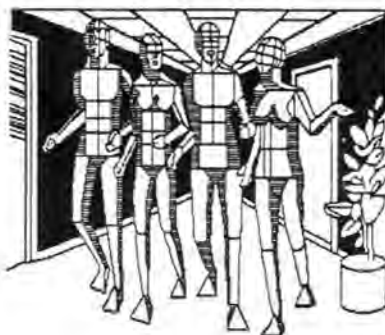
It is the responsibility of each player to try and bring several new players into the sport, bringing Ultimate back into the growth mode. The Tunas, for example, started as a group of friends that played traditional sports together. We started adding new players while working extremely hard to better the new found skills of our existing players. In just over two years of tournament play we made it to the National Championships. The state of the art in Ultimate has increased dramatically since then; but in this sport nothing can stop hard work and a can-do attitude.

My hope as captain of a national power is that more players can get in to the sport for more of the right reasons. The sport demands more of an athlete than just about any other type of competitive sport, yet many players fail to put in the work to reach their peak. Ultimate is not unlike other sports in that you can only break through new levels by finding your ability threshold.

In conclusion, I am proud to be associated with a sport so demanding of my abilities. I hope that we as players can internalize our intensities into better and better play on the field and perhaps less denigration of the sport on the sidelines. Isn't that what the sport deserves.

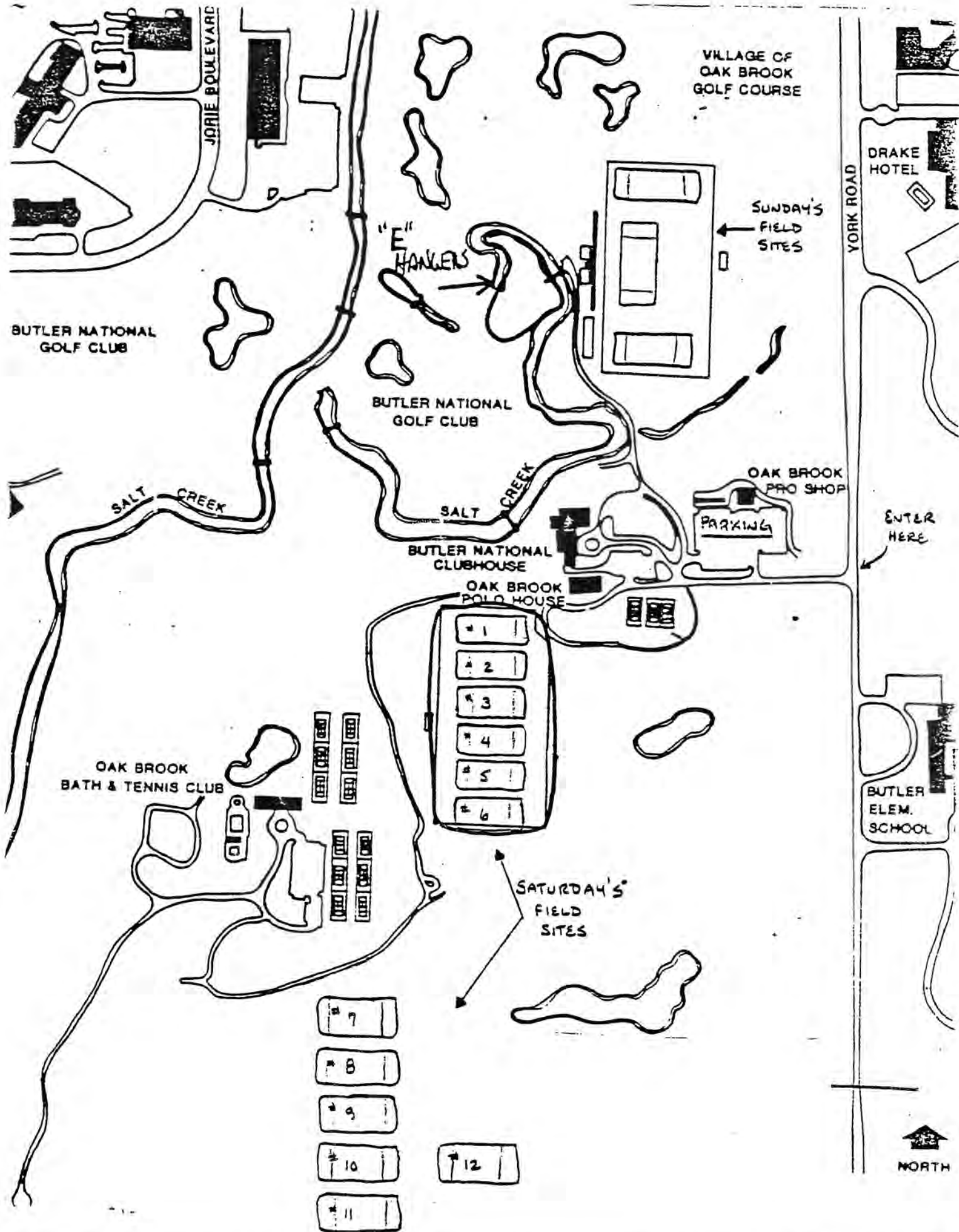

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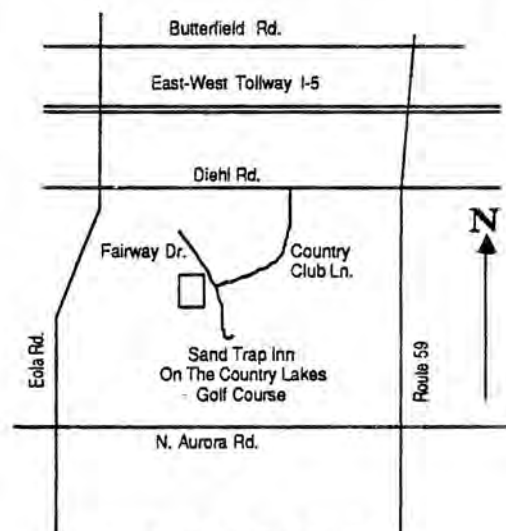

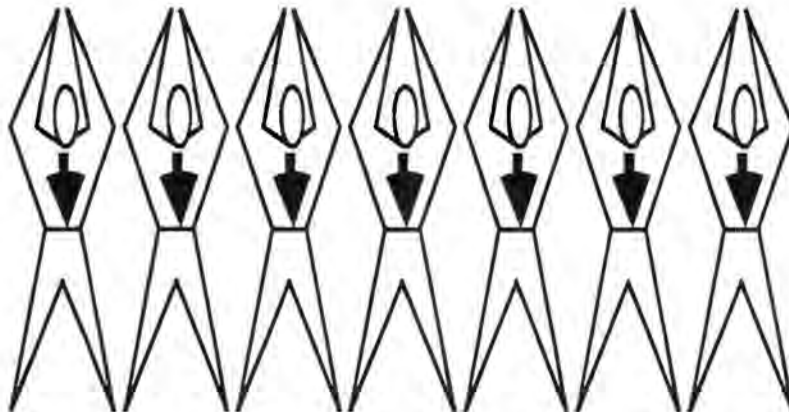
