### NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COLLEGIATE SECTIONALS Strongest Section in the Nation

This year marks the sixth year of the Collegiate National Series. While the eastern colleges have had a longer history, the 1st National Collegiate Champion was crowned in 1984. The Northern California Section, by far has been the strongest and most competitive of all the sections and regions in the UPA (Ultimate Players Association). Having already produced two National Champions in the early stages of this series, our section has clearly been the leaders in this great game. Stanford inaugurated this tradition with the first National Crown (1984) at Boston. Las Positas (Chabot) College, captured the 1987 title at Penn State. Last year Stanford went undefeated throughout the college season only to be upset on a windy afternoon in the semifinals of the 1988 National Championships. Western Regional second place finisher, UCSB went on to keep the national crown in the west last year.

The sectional tournament has historically come down to the rivalry between Stanford and Chabot (now called Las Positas). This year UC Berkeley came through league games undefeated. Both UCB and Stanford have won collegiate invitational tournaments and should be the teams battling it out for the Northern California Collegiate Championship. Don't count out some other impressive teams. Since there was a four way tie for second place, it's anyone's race.
