


#### SPIRIT OF THE GAME

Such actions as taunting opposing players, dangerous aggression, belligerent intimidation, intentional infractions, or other 'win-at-all-costs' behavior are contrary to the Spirit of the Game and must be avoided by all players."

Spirit of the Game sets Ultimate apart from other competitive team sports. For over 30 years, Ultimate has flourished, reaching a highly competitive level, without the use of referees. #### Medical Support

The Expedition School Medical Support Team is once again providing on site medical support for this year's 2011 USA Ultimate Texas H.S. Championship. The Expedition School will have 1 Medic and 1 student Athletic Trainer staged throughout the tournament to provide ultimate care to all the athletes. We will be located at the Medical Support tent next to Frisbee Central.

If a player is injured - do not attempt to move the player - call the onsite Expedition School Medical Support Team and they will come to you.

Please bring health insurance cards and or medical release forms for all athletes to help expedite care.

Please bring pertinent medications (i.e. epipens, etc.) and communicate with the Expedition School and Event Director on any athlete with a medical condition so that we can better advocate and assist with proper care.

#### Concussion Policy:

Concussion protocols will be implemented - kids must sit out 20 minutes post injury and will be assessed on scene if they can return to play. If the athlete is asymptomatic of the concussion signs /symptoms and has no history of prior concussions - they may return to play post 20 minutes.

Lightning/tornado protocol - if lighting or thunder is spotted or heard, and or inclement weather is noted: play will immediately stop and all athletes will be directed towards a lightning safe structure (concession area).




