I'd like to welcome both players and spectators to the 1996 UPA National Championships. This year's Women's Division welcomes 14 teams from across the country and the new expanded format promises some exciting matchups each and every round. Returning from last year are National Champions Lady Godiva from Boston, Ozone from Atlanta, Nemesis II from Chicago, Philly Peppers from Philadelphia, Hucksters from Florida and Jane Air from Minneapolis. Rounding out the field are Schwa from Portland, Rare Air from Bolder, San Diego's Safari, Category 5 from Wilmington, Wild Roses from Ithaca, Twister from Boston, and both Da'Fence and Homebrood from the Bay area. Lady Godiva is certainly the favorite but Schwa's victory at Northwest regionals and semi-finalist appearance at Tune-Up definitely places them in the running. Semi-finals on Saturday should be exciting with this strong a field and the afternoon finals on Sunday are one game no one should miss!

Be sure to also check out the Women's Master's Division. This is the 6th year of hosting the division and this year's field includes a team from Hawaii representing the Southwest region. Following the strong showing last year by the Northeast's What?, Boston's Great Dames are the early favorites. However, in this Division, it's anyone's guess who is going to be hot over the weekend and we maybe in for some surprises by finals time on Saturday. Be sure to be there!

Nationals is a chance for both players and fans to see ultimate played at its highest level. The Spirit of the Game is an integral part of Ultimate and I anticipate that this year's National Championships will be a showcase for good spirited, competitive ultimate. Congratulations to all the teams for qualifying and let the best teams take home the prize!

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Good Luck To All The Ultimate Teams



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Big Ass Truck: The dust has settled in the powerful central region, but the Big Ass Truck rumbles on. Fueled by gatorade, powerbars, chips and beer, Truck will grind into the National championships for the first time in its brief existence. With a few cagey veterans in the cab, and a host of young upstarts locked in the trailer, B.A.T. comes to Plano comfortable with our underdog status, eager to prove that the Truck will not roll over under stiff competition.

Miami: What is it that tells you that it's this time of year? Is it your shredded muscles or maybe your work clothes caking on the scrapes on your body. How about your significant other's vague enthusiasm over your dedication to the team turning to cold indifference. How many years in a row is it now? How many decades for some? If you are reading this program and you are one of the teams in it, you know it's worth every little bit of sacrifice and then some. It's the sixth consecutive Nationals appearance for the Miami Refugees and were as fired up as could be. Two sessions a week at Camp Fisher (interval training with our resident endorphin junkie) and three more of practice have us primed and ready to go the distance. This year has seen some evolution (and regression) in the elite teams. This has the critics thinking twice about their picks for this year's rankings. It's as wide open as it has ever been and only eight victories stand between now and the National Championship Title.

Philadelphia Rage: Philadelphia Rage started in 1993 with players from Double Secret, Gimme Five Bucks, and Philmore, and was painfully close to making Nationals in each of its first three years.

That experience, along with a trip to the World Club Championships in Street, England, three consecutive Turkey Swamp Swamp-Thing titles, a PADA Mother's Day title, and two consecutive spring MA Regional titles has created a tight knit squad. Having added some new talent (young, and old, and British), this squad has finally qualified for Nationals and plans to make the most of the opportunity.

Boulder Beer Ultimate: Boulder Beer Ultimate makes its second trip in three years to Nationals, qualifying as the second team from the Southwest Region. In Lexington in 1994 Boulder Ultimate went 2-3 defeating Rhino Slam and Chain while losing to DOG, Z and Chesapeake.

This season Boulder Ultimate received sponsorships from Rockies Brewing Co. (d.b.a. Boulder Beer), Advanced Probing Systems, Pearl Izumi, and Odwalla Juices. These sponsors helped Boulder Beer Ultimate travel to Kansas City for Fools which it won, Daweena in Salt Lake City (lost in semis to the Desert Rats) and Cal States (lost in quarters to Rhino). In July Boulder Ultimate hosted the 4th of July Tournament where it lost to Houston in the semis. During pool play of the 4th of July Boulder went 8-1 defeating San Diego (Suds), Chain, and Saucy Jack. At the Tuneup Boulder advanced to the quarters of the winners bracket but lost to DOG.

The team won the Rocky Mountain Sectional defeating Johnny Bravo 15-8 in the final and bested The Santa Barbara Condors 15-8 in the finals of the losers bracket at the

Southwestern Regional in Las Vegas.

The team is led by tri-captains Lorenzo Verbeck, David Gessner, and Bob Pease. The team hopes to make some noise at the big dance.

Randalls Island: Broken glass, hard fields, next to Harlem, this is Randalls Island. It's very special to us. We're not doing this for ourselves, we're doing it for Randall man. Do it for Randall!! It's the rock, it grows on you. We're like a family, we're even going to have a camp-out there. Not just anybody gets to play on the rock.

Snapple: From Pawtucket RI, the training ground of New England's greats, rises a new cribbage club that makes room in their busy schedules for some ultimate. This team has people asking, "Who are these guys?" We ask "Are you going to deal or what?"

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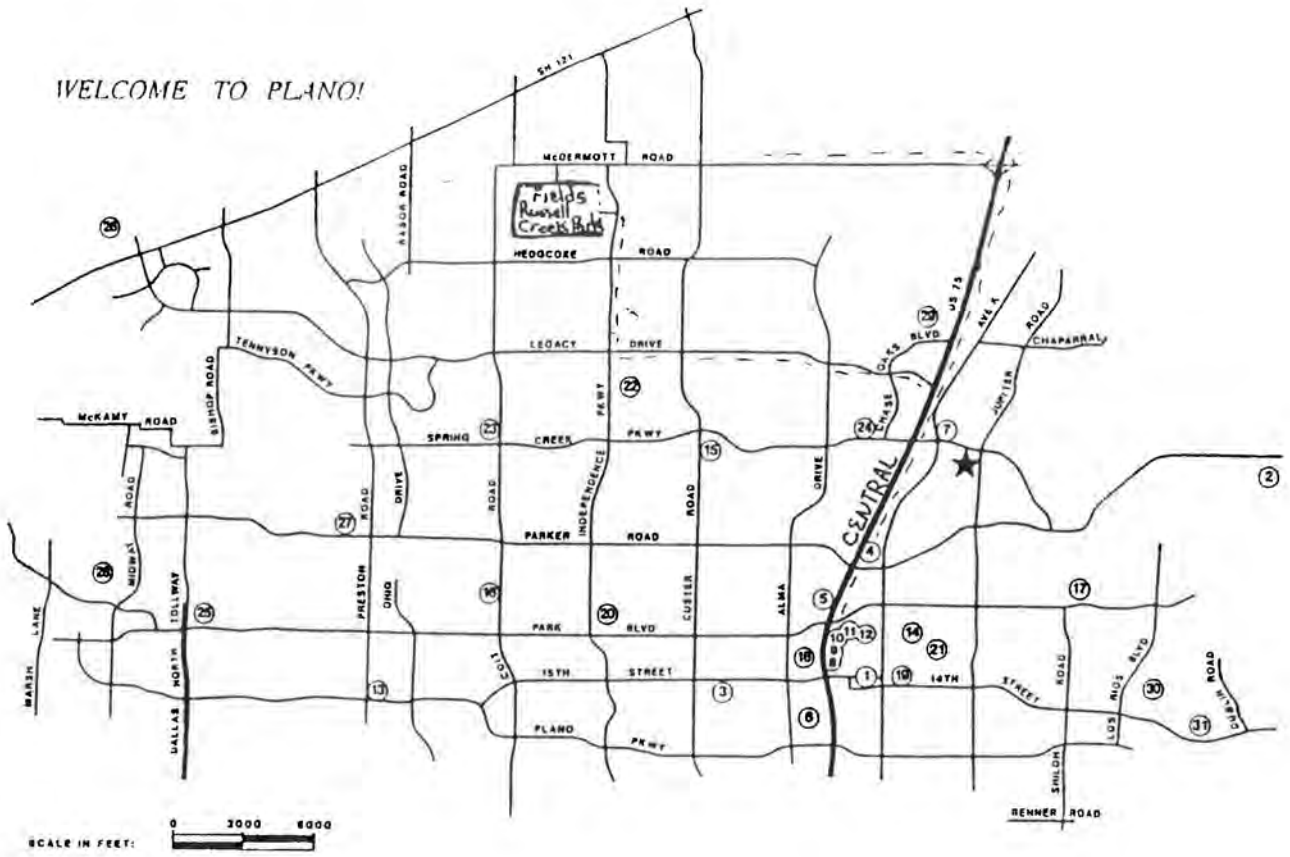

 Look for Ozone in Blue at Nationals '96

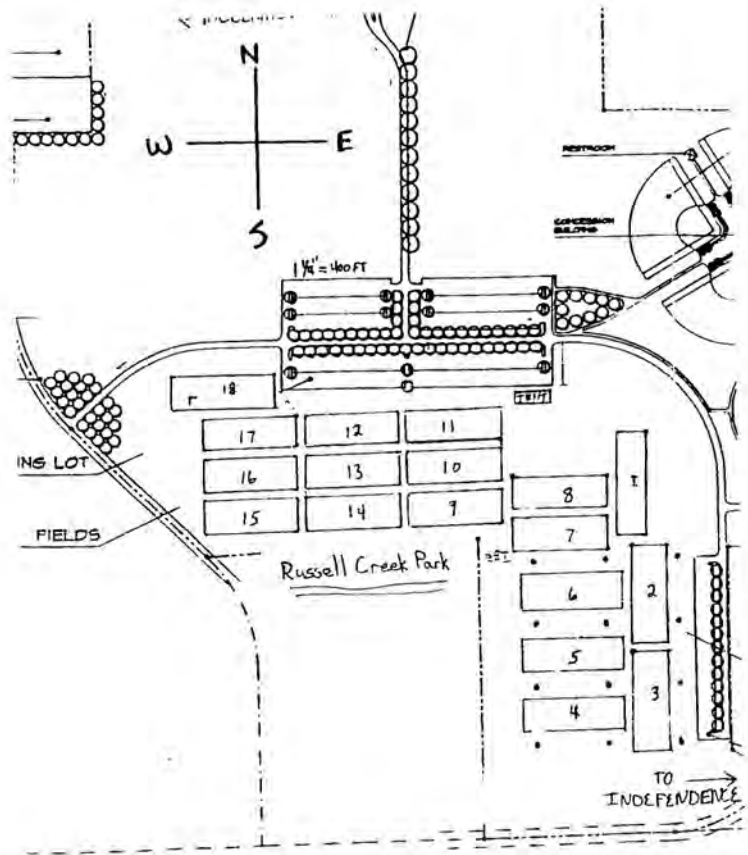
