























































Portugal, June 2017 Hello Beach Ultimate Lovers!




Thank you to our unbelievable organising team who has been working hard since early 2016 on this event. To our families who continuously supported us and made it possible, we will beforever grateful!



All registered players, team members, staff, volunteers, media and VIP's will receive an event accreditation attached to an event lanyard. To be eligible to utilise the event services and to play, you must keep your accreditation with you all all times. Please be aware that without your accreditation card you will not be able to access the official meetings or functions.

Please try and avoid bringing large bags to the Opening & Closing Ceremonies. Large rucksacks or cases will not be allowed into the grandstand as they can create obstructions and impede exits in an emergency.



Spirit of the Game

Ultimate relies upon a Spirit of the Game that places the responsibility for fair play on every player.

Spirit of the Game (SOTG) is the mindful behavior practiced by players prior to, during and after a game of beach ultimate. It encompasses attitudes and skills such as good knowledge and application of the rules, fair-mindedness, safe play and spatial awareness, clear and calm communication, and a positive and respectful attitude towards teammates, fans, and opponents, in a mutual effort to protect the basic joy of play.

We strongly believe that Spirit of the Game helps people to improve their skills in polite, calm and respectful communication even in difficult situations and to make friends all over the world despite ethnic, national or religious differences. Spirit promotes understanding and peace in our sport, and we hope that through you players, that influence can even spread beyond and make real changes in the outside world.

At WCBU 2017 every team in every division has chosen a spirit captain. It is this player's responsibility to work with their team and all opposition teams to ensure that the highest standard of Spirit of the Game is maintained throughout the competition.

A spirit scoring system has been developed to evaluate the other team immediately after each game. With all players involved and led by the spirit captain, each team fills in a spirit scoresheet. Using guidelines found in the spirit scoring examples document, each team can provide a more consistent score for the other team. The spirit scoring system therefore serves as an educational tool where teams can learn how to improve based on standardized feedback.

To celebrate Spirit of the Game an award will be presented to the team with the highest total spirit score in each division. Winning this prize is held in the highest regard.

Best wishes this week at WCBU. Players, you represent the pinnacle of our sport in your ability and in your demonstration of spirit. Fans and spectators, you can look forward to some amazing displays of both!
