Welcome to Logroño, Spain, home to the WFDF 2025 World Under-24 Ultimate Championships!

The WFDF World Under-24 Ultimate Championships (WU24) will be hosted by the Local Organising Committee (LOC), led by Max Vitali along with a team of experienced key staff. This exciting event will be held in Logroño, Spain, from Saturday, June 21st to Saturday, June 28th, 2025, inclusive (8 days).

The world's best national teams for Under 24 players will compete in the Women's, Open, and Mixed divisions. We expect teams from over 20 nations, comprising approximately 1,000 participants, to take part in this championship. Players born between January 1st, 2002, and December 31st, 2011, are eligible to compete (please check the WFDF Rules Appendix for details).

Logroño, with its vibrant cultural scene and historic downtown, is an ideal host city for this international event. The tournament will take place at the modern facilities of Pradoviejo Sport Complex and UDL Ciudad Deportiva, while the opening game and the finals will be played at Las Gaunas stadium.

We are incredibly excited to have this chance to host the first WFDF sanctioned World Ultimate Championship ever held in Spain, and we want to make sure that the teams, the players, the managers and their guests and spectators will have the chance to enjoy their Spanish experience.

All teams are strongly reminded that NO BOOKINGS for flights, visas, or hotels should be made until we close the team registration (collect fees) for the event, once we are sure it is viable with critical mass.

Teams from all WFDF member National Federations who are in good standing are welcome to register teams to participate in the event.

Dates:

WU24 will be an eight (8) days tournament from Saturday 21st to Saturday 28th June, 2025 inclusive. Should any weather events necessitate changes to the schedule, we will adjust accordingly to ensure the finals are played as scheduled on or before day 8.

A provisional competition format will be shared after team fees are collected when schedules will be tailored to the division sizes. Day 1 (Sat 21st June) will include the Parade of Nations, Opening Ceremony, and an opening game - all teams should make plans to play a game (if required) on Day 1. Day 8 (Sat 28th June) will be a short day with limited play for some teams only - schedule pending.

On-site registration will take place in the lead-up to the Tournament after teams arrive in Logroño, Spain. You will be informed of your booking time and location for team registration at a later date.







WU24 DATES ALL TEAMS PLAYING FINAL CEREMONY FINAL PARTY

Coaches & Captains' Meeting & the Spirit Captains' Meetings will take place on Saturday 21st June, in the morning BEFORE the tournament starts. Attendance by at least one (1) representative from EACH TEAM is preferred to attend each meeting, please plan your travel accordingly. For teams who have no representatives at the venue during the meeting times, you can pre-register your absence to receive the meeting minutes via email.

The Parade of Nations and Opening Ceremony will take place in the afternoon of Saturday 21st June and all teams are requested to participate in uniform.

It is anticipated that teams will play up to 2 games per day on days 2-7 with placement, semis and finals games as well as games needed to round out the schedule played on days 7 and 8. There is a possibility that teams/divisions will be granted a rest day within the schedule. Note that if any changes to the schedule are necessary, we cannot promise a set number of games for teams.

The official athletes' party will be on Friday 27th June, while medal ceremonies will take place immediately after each final. **The closing ceremony will take place at the end of the last final of the WU24 tournament.**

L.O.C. (Local Organizing Committee):

The core of the LOC for WU24 in Logroño is composed of six individuals who will run the event: Massimiliano Vitali (Max) (Tournament Director), Celso Jubera (Logistics), Nagore Lejarza (Social Media & Marketing), Jenny Nomikou (Accommodation, Gemma Pérez (Finance & Registration), and Matteo Ercoli (Logistics & Branding).

Together, we have organized Ultimate tournaments worldwide and managed large cultural events. Max and his team will have support from the Disctintos Logroño Ultimate Team, Logroño Deporte and the city mayor's office - joined by an experienced team of staff and volunteers to ensure a smooth and successful event. This dedicated and diverse group will collaborate with the local federation FEDV and WFDF to give all the players, staff and spectators a great experience.

Logroño:

Logroño is a city in northern Spain and the capital of La Rioja. Nestled in the Ebro valley, it is renowned for its top quality of life, excellent food and mild climate. Surrounded by vineyards and close to the mountains Logroño is the perfect venue to host sport events and to have the players enjoy a real Spanish culture immersive experience.

Getting there:

Logroño is accessible from many international airports, which host a great number of flights from multiple destinations during the summer season. Your team can choose to fly into *Madrid (350km), *Bilbao (150km), *Vitoria (100km), Other airports also to consider are: Zaragoza (170km), Santander (230km) and San Sebastian (180km). From all airports, participants can reach Logroño by bus, train, or car within a few hours. Direct flights to Logroño are only available from Madrid.

WU24 VENUES

A major transportation company can serve airports marked with an asterix (*) to transport teams that require it, ensuring a smooth and hassle-free journey directly from the airport to their chosen accommodation. All services will be chargeable to the user.

More information about available options and prices will be provided to team managers in the next bulletin.

Playing Venues:

Ciudad Deportiva Pradoviejo (CDP), will be the main venue for our event, featuring eight (8) synthetic fields, with stands for more than 8000 people on 5 different fields, comprehensive facilities including changing rooms, showers, and services for the players. CDP will be the core of the competition and the place for day gatherings

The Ciudad Deportiva de la Unión Deportiva Logroñés (UDL) will serve as a secondary venue with excellent sports infrastructure and 5 top-quality fields (both in natural grass and synthetic last generation ones) and facilities.

The Las Gaunas City Stadium will be the place where the opening ceremony, night game and the finals will be played

Accommodation:

The goal is to have all the players staying in the most compact area possible, in order to optimise transportation and to allow the players to enjoy the city, the event, and all the social gatherings that we will be running through the week-long tournament.

All the official tournament accommodation reserved through the LOC comes with the transportation service to and from the playing fields, and to and from the parties and social events (if required).

Accommodation options:

TYPE 1 (Basic level)

La Playa, Dorm Rooms, Bungalows and Campsite: La Playa is a nice venue of which all the rooms and bungalows will be completely reserved for the WU24 players and staff. It offers a series of different accommodation options (Shared rooms with bunk beds, Bungalows, and Camping option); it is very close from the Las Norias Swimming pools (see players' services).

A convenient bus line (#9) leaves right outside the La Playa and arrives in front of the playing fields in approximately 20 minutes.

Shared rooms with bunk beds: Within the "Camping LaPlaya", these accommodations offer bunk beds in different size rooms (from 8 to 14 guests per room). Price per person: 24€/night

Bungalows: These bungalows are within the "Camping LaPlaya" and host between 4 and 8 People per bungalow. Have a small kitchen (Fridge, microwave) Price per person: 32€/night

Camping option: "LaPlaya" offers the possibility to set your tents or to park your RV, connect it to the campsite utilities and enjoy the facility infrastructure. This is the same exact location of the bungalows and the Budget accommodation.

Please contact us for a quotation if you want this option.

La Playa has 2-3 standard restaurants directly outside their venue. It is not possible to expect to cook for large groups within the La Playa accommodations.

TYPE 2 (Budget level)

Budget hotels: These are good quality low-cost hotels and apartments that will be completely dedicated to the players. Rooms are for 2-3-4 people each. Due to the small size of each of them it is a priority for us to optimize the room availability according to the team sizes, because of this, these reservations will pass through the organization. Price per person: 40-45 €/night

Some hotels might offer bed & Breakfast - please check carefully on your booking about the details. These hotels are downtown and there are a multitude of cafes and restaurants.

TYPE 3 (Mid-range level)

3-4* hotels: These are very good quality hotels. We have a certain number of rooms reserved for you in these hotels. To access them the organisation will give you a unique code to share with the hotel at the moment you'll contact them. This will grant you the sufficient number of rooms and the agreed upon price.

The teams are expected to book and pay these hotels by themselves. Prices per person: 50-70 €/night

Info for teams that want to book outside the official accommodation offers: Logroño is a very compact city, still, to be able to enjoy both the tournament and the city at its fullest we strongly recommend that you either book a hotel in the downtown area or make sure to have a transportation services to move from your accommodation to the fields and the social event venues (you can check the Logroño bus timetable at http://transporteurbano.logro-o.org/).

Due to the touristy high season, we also expect most of the downtown hotels to have limited options to host big groups of people.

NOTE: Only bookings made through the LOC for the official accommodation will have access to the transportation services to and from the fields (and the parties, if needed).

IF YOU ARE LOOKING TO ARRIVE BEFORE JUNE 19, PLEASE NOTE THAT THE CITY FESTIVAL WILL BE ON, BOOKING HOTELS MIGHT BE CHALLENGING FOR BIG GROUPS, WE SUGGEST YOU TO GET IN TOUCH WITH US AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, WE'LL PRIORITIZE YOUR REQUEST.

Food:

Breakfast - Teams - self arrange - We recommend you book accommodation that has breakfast included in the rate.

Lunch - LOC has arranged for a full range (vegetarian, vegan) of food and beverage concessions to be available for purchase at the venues.

Dinner - There are dinners served at the playing fields for evening meals. Should a team wish to make a bulk reservation for meals near their accommodation, they will have a chance to work with the LOC and their hotel to do so in the coming months.

Logroño is renowned for the quality of its food and its accessibility. We are arranging agreements with local restaurants to allow you to fully enjoy the Logroño food scene; we are working to ensure all teams and volunteers have access to a comprehensive meal package if requested, or leave them free to roam the city to enjoy their Spanish experience.

Logroño is not only one of the best city in the world for tapas, it offers a huge variety of restaurants and food options for all budgets, however, large groups wanting to eat together will need to get organised in order to do so. We want to encourage teams to experience the local food scene, realities and flavours.

Food packages and concessions details will be presented in the next bulletin.

WU24 HEALTH & MEDICAL



All event participants (athletes, coaches and team support) should obtain travel insurance prior to booking flights and health insurance before leaving your home country. WFDF and the LOC do not provide coverage for participants outside of the general first aid administered at the fields. There are always risks associated with playing Ultimate and travelling. WU24 will have medical staff on site to deal with first aid and assess injuries, there may be injuries or illness in which players need follow up medical attention or emergency visits to local hospitals. Please be aware that depending on your passport and nationality, the Spanish rules for access the public healthcare system may vary: All EU and European Economic Area (EEA) nationals below retirement age who visit Spain for a short holiday are entitled to free or reduced-cost emergency medical healthcare and treatments at all Spanish public medical centers and hospitals on production of a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Essentially, the treatment you are entitled to will be equivalent to that which Spanish nationals receive, but this can depend on the level of public healthcare provision in your own country of residence – so it is worth double-checking before you depart. Non-Europeans visiting Spain will most likely have to prove they have adequate medical insurance before they are granted entry to the country. It is, therefore, highly recommended to have a valid health insurance policy before your arrival.

All Spanish state hospitals are required to provide vital primary healthcare to any patient who is admitted to hospital with life-threatening injuries or illness, regardless of their ability to pay.

WFDF and the LOC kindly request that all players and event participants acknowledge these risks and understand that WFDF and the LOC cannot be held liable for any risk or cost associated with injury, travel/event cancellations or bad health at WU24. All event participants should alleviate some personal financial liability by purchasing your own travel and health insurance to make sure you are covered for any medical issues or event/travel cancellations that could arise. Participants will be required to sign an Event Participant Agreement published in advance of the event.





WU24 VISAS







VISAS:

Once the event bid list is published and your team is registered, we encourage each team and player to make specific and timely enquiries about obtaining a visa to enter Spain and the European Union. Teams and Players are responsible for obtaining the correct paperwork to visit Spain to compete at the WFDF 2025 World Under-24 Ultimate Championships. We cannot provide specific advice on the process; however, we do strongly recommend that you get started as soon as possible.

WFDF can provide your team manager/administrator with a letter confirming your team's registration at the event. WFDF can provide players with a letter confirming your participation as a player at the event after the players fees are paid and after the NF has supplied a roster endorsement letter with your name on it.

Specific player letters for visa appointments can only be done after players have registered and paid their fees; we require confirmation from the National Federation that they endorse the player on the roster. The following details for all the members of your team are required:

- Full name (as shown on passport);
- Passport number;
- Date of birth;
- Role on team (i.e. player, coach, manager, etc.)

Please fill out the required fields on the <u>online form</u>. Make sure you leave us some time to produce this document: do not assume that we can send it back the same day. Please note: we cannot and will not provide a formal "invitation" to attend the event and non-ability to enter Spain is not grounds to request a refund for a team and/or player fees.

We recommend EVERY TEAM makes specific enquiries to fully understand visa and travel requirements.

For all proof of participation letters (team or individual) please fill out the form here. Letter production for events will close 8 weeks prior to the tournament (15th April 2025).

Please do not leave your request late. DO NOT EMAIL US - only applications via the online form will be responded to.

WU24 ELIGIBILITY







W24 Eligibility:

Teams from all WFDF National Federation (NF) members (in good standing) are invited to participate at WU24 in Logroño, Spain. Any late applications for bids after the 20th November are at the sole discretion of WFDF.

WU24 will operate divisions following the team eligibility rules for team rosters (Section D) with a minimum of six teams per division:

- Under-24 Mixed (U24X)
 - Female and Male identifying players who are at least 14 years old and not twenty-four (24) years old in 2025 (anyone born between 1st January 2002 and 31st December 2011 is eligible).
- Under-24 Open (U24)
 - Female and Male identifying players who are at least 14 years old and not twenty-four (24) years old in 2025 (anyone born between 1st January 2002 and 31st December 2011 is eligible).
- Under-24 Women's (U24W)
 - Female and Male identifying players who are at least 14 years old and not twenty-four (24) years old in 2025 (anyone born between 1st January 2002 and 31st December 2011 is eligible).

The event is open to all players who meet the age and eligibility criteria and must not be twenty-four (24) years old or older during the calendar year in which the tournament concludes.

WFDF strives to protect transgender athletes and to recognise the importance of autonomy of gender identity in sport and has created clear guidelines with minimally invasive requirements for TUE submissions. The guidelines were developed by the Medical and Anti-Doping Committee. WU24 will abide by timelines and requirements as outlined in the WFDF Transgender Athlete and Differences in Sex Development (DSD) Athlete Policy. Please note that there are different timelines for transgender athletes under age 24 than for transgender athletes age 24 or older. Please be sure to read through this document with your athletes when assessing eligibility.

- WFDF will invoice and collect all fees for WU24. All fees are in US Dollars \$ (please ensure your payment is made in the right currency).
- The team fee is NOT reimbursable for any team that withdraws after payment of the team fee. The player fee can be transferred to another player but is NOT reimbursable (subject to certain exceptions and medical restrictions).
- All bank fees and transfer charges are at the cost of the payer if there are any outstanding moneys, they will be collected in cash during on-site event registration.

Player Fees will include event accreditation, field and roster access for play, access to all player zones and meetings, access to the party and also the event gift and access to the podium to receive medals.

Non-playing Team Support fees are for people traveling and associated with the team (coaches, medics, support, admin and guests) but are not taking the field to play. They will receive the same benefits as a player but will not be on any roster and are not entitled to play.

Spectators are non-accredited individuals who will not be able to participate with the team or take part in any of the event or team functions and will be treated as spectators.

WU24 CANCELLATION POLICY

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Be advised that the event may be forced to cancel by governmental orders or may be perceived to be unsafe and cancelled by the organisers. The organisers may be forced into a last-minute cancellation due to events beyond their reasonable control. If the organisers are unable or unwilling to host the event or any specific participants at the event for reasons beyond their reasonable control, the event may be rescheduled, if possible. If a reschedule is not reasonably feasible, participants, teams and spectators may be unable to recoup any costs already expended for the cancelled event. Each team/participant is strongly encouraged to consider purchasing insurance to cover the costs (travel/accommodations/etc.) as a result of any cancellation or rescheduling of the event by governmental authorities, the organisers, or others.

If any new information presents itself that would warrant an event cancellation we will report back immediately to teams. Countries should continue to make their own assessment, and should remain in contact with the organisers with up-to-date information if any concerns arise. WFDF also reminds all teams that team fee and minimum roster invoice payments are the only formal registration for a team. Any bids not paid on time will be revoked. Only once payments are received will WFDF confirm critical mass for the event to proceed (after 15th January 2025) Teams should not make firm flight or hotel bookings until that time.

TRANSPORTATION TO LOGROÑO (JUNE 15 TO 21)



Teams needing transportation from the airport to their accommodation must complete the <u>BUS</u>
<u>TO LOGROÑO: TEAMS REGISTRATION</u> form.

IN THIS PHASE THE TRIP IS BOOKABLE ONLY FOR TEAMS (NOT INDIVIDUALS).



If you need transportation from major Spanish airports to Logroño, and would like us to provide this service, please complete this form. If your team has already arranged transportation - either with us or independently - no action is required.

Your team can choose between two options:

SCHEDULED BUSES will be available from Madrid and Bilbao airports (MAD 40 € and BIO 25 €), from where we will have tens of buses going back and forth in the days prior to the event. It is expected you'll have to wait for players of other teams and or volunteers; we'll work to reduce that waiting time to the minimum.

PRIVATE TEAM TRANSPORT pick you up from your arrival location in Spain, whether it's an airport or your hotel in any city, and will depart for Logroño as soon as your entire group has arrived. The price will vary depending on the departure location, and in some cases, volunteers may join your trip. However, the bus will be arranged according to your delegation's specific needs.

Please note that private transportation is subject to availability, and we may not always be able to accommodate requests. Availability will depend on your arrival date and time.

Before filling the form, please note that we will be needing the following information:

- Day you want to reach Logroño.
- Airport or place you want to be picked up.
- Number of people traveling.
- Expected arrival time.
- Flight number (if applies).
- Any information you believe is relevant.

If you have already accepted and signed an offer for transportation to Logroño, you do not need to request it again. **IF YOU HAVE ONLY BOOKED TRANSPORTATION TO LOGRONO**, please read the next section carefully for return travel arrangements.

RETURN TRANSPORTATION (JUNE 28-30)

To ensure your team gets to the airport on time for your flight, please note that moving over 1,000 players simultaneously is a complex operation, private buses to Madrid (MAD) or Bilbao (BIO) may not be available on the way back due to logistical constraints.

FOOD

Logroño is renowned as one of Spain's top cities for food, tapas, and exceptional service, and we want your dining experience to reflect that.
