Facility staff, event staff and security will be checking to make sure people are following the site rules. 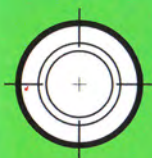

WORLD FLYING DISC FEDERATION

GAME ADVISORS

A brief description of the Game Advisor (GA) role

Refer to Appendix B6.3 for more details



AIM

The aim of GAs is to support the Players to self-officiate as effectively and efficiently as possible. Players remain responsible for making and resolving all game calls.



RULES ADVICE

During stoppages GAs can help to clarify the rules, if asked by the Players.



TIME LIMITS

GAs closely monitor time limits in accordance with the rules, including in between points, time outs, and during discussions, and encourage teams to comply with these rules.



NON BINDING ADVICE

If Players need help resolving any call they may ask the GA for their advice. This advice is non-binding and Players must still make the call.



WHISTLES

GAs give information to Players about time limits by using whistles, but also by providing verbal advice.



SIDELINE ROLE

GAs remain on the sideline during play. They may come on to the field during stoppages, if needed.



SPIRIT OF THE GAME

If GAs have concerns about Spirit they can talk to the Captains, the Players involved, or can even call a SOTG Stoppage to help the Players resolve the issue.



MISCONDUCT

In extreme circumstances GAs can issue warnings and/or enforce sanctions in accordance with the WFDF Conduct Policy.



OFFSIDE



PICK

HAND SIGNALS

GAs use hand signals to echo the calls made by the Players, for the benefit of other Players and spectators. They also actively signal to inform the opposition of Offside violations, but the Players must still make the call.



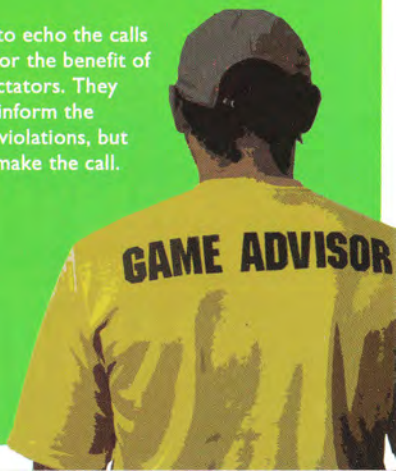

LEBANON SPORTS COMPLEX

Alcohol will be sold during pool play games at Lebanon Sports Complex. The MadTree Beer Garden will be set up near the showcase fields in the Social Tent.

ATRIUM STADIUM-MASON HIGH SCHOOL

Alcohol will NOT be sold for the Opening Ceremony, Showcase game, or Finals due to venue restrictions. No alcohol will be permitted on the premises and bags are subject to search upon entrance to the stadium.

Must be 21 years or older to drink and present a valid ID: Drivers License, Passport, or Other Government ID. Alcohol may not be consumed outside the designated Beer Garden. No outside alcohol permitted. Cash or Credit Card only. No refunds. Please drink responsibly.

BREAKFAST

Breakfast will be provided by Official Tournament Hotels each morning. See each hotel for breakfast hours.

LUNCH & DINNER *(at the playing fields)*

Concessions and multiple local food trucks will be available at Atrium Stadium-Mason High School and Lebanon Sports Complex. These will offer a variety of choices at different price points. Players and spectators will be able to purchase food and drinks with US currency or by credit card.

DINNER

There are many dinner locations with varied price ranges within walking distance of most of the official tournament hotels. ACCREDITATION

ALL registered players, team members, staff, volunteers, media and VIPs will receive an event accreditation attached to an event lanyard. To be eligible to enter Lebanon Sports Complex and Atrium Stadium-Mason High School, to utilize the event services, and to play, you must keep your accreditation on you at all times.

Please wear your admission lanyard at all times.

Entrance to the venues and tournament party will be refused to any person noticeably under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or any behavior-modifying substance, and to any person behaving, or considered likely to behave, violently, harmfully or contrary to public order. In relation to all of these matters, the assessment of event staff will be determinative and final. Entrance will also be refused to any person who attempts to bring in prohibited items.

ANTI-DOPING MESSAGE

The World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF) requires ALL athletes and coaches/medical staff competing in the WFDF 2018 World Ultimate Club Championships (WUCC) in Cincinnati to complete the Real Winner education course prior to the event.

The "Real Winner" educational anti-doping online tool can be accessed under the following link: <http://wfdf.realwinner.org>

Real Winner is an internet based tool which WFDF has used for the past several years. This is an educational exercise and test to enhance the knowledge of Anti-Doping matters for elite athletes and their support personnel concerning subjects such as doping control procedures, the WADA Prohibited List, athletes' whereabouts reporting and Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE).

Spirit of the Game (SOTG) is the mindful behavior practiced by players prior to, during and after a game of Ultimate. It encompasses attitudes and skills such as good knowledge and application of the rules, fair-mindedness, safe play and spatial awareness, clear and calm communication, and a positive and respectful attitude towards teammates, fans, and opponents, in a mutual effort to protect the basic joy of play.

We strongly believe that Spirit of the Game helps people to improve their skills in polite, calm and respectful communication even in difficult situations and to make friends all over the world despite ethnic, national or religious differences. Spirit promotes understanding and peace in our sport, and we hope that through you players, that influence can even spread beyond and make real changes in the outside world.

At WUCC, every team in every division has chosen a Spirit Captain. It is this player's responsibility to work with their team and all opposition teams to ensure that the highest standard of the Spirit of the Game is maintained throughout the competition (both on and off the field).

A spirit scoring system has been developed to evaluate the other team immediately after each game. With all players involved and led by the spirit captain, each team fills in a spirit score sheet. Using guidelines found in the spirit scoring examples document, each team can provide a more consistent score for the other team. The spirit scoring system therefore serves as an educational tool where teams can learn how to improve based on standardized feedback.

To celebrate Spirit of the Game, an award will be presented to the team with the highest total spirit score in each division. Winning this award is held in the highest regard and all teams strive to achieve this.
