SITE INFORMATION

THE SITE

The playing fields are located just south of the main stadium about a mile or so. Directional signs will be placed to direct you.

HEADOUARTERS TENT

The tent is located midway between the two major polo fields and will house tournament headquarters, sales of T-Shirts and Discs.

HOSPITALITY WATER/ICE

A Hospitality Tent will be located next to the HQ Tent and is provided compliments of CUERVO GOLD who are providing water supplies for the players. Ice will be available at the tent as well. NOTE: There is no supply of running water at playing site. Although Cuervo is supplying water, players may want to bring some of their own as well.

FOOD SERVICE

Food and refreshments will be available near HQ Tent.

SALES

We have a new, exciting T-Shirt and Disc design for '91 Beach Bowl. We also have a limited supply of 1991 Nationals Discs as well as a new "Palm Beach County" Disc.

FIRST AID

Available at HQ Tent.

RESTROOMS

Ample portable toilets will be available on site. There are also restrooms at the main stadium.

TELEPHONES

Telephones are located at Main Polo Stadium.

TRASH

Sunburst Sanitation has provided trash containers and dumpsters. Please help us keep the facility clean.

PARTY

Free beer will be available after the final games on Saturday afternoon and after the fields are clean.

Another party will take place pool-side at the Holiday Inn on Belvedere (HQ Hotel) beginning at about 9:00 until midnight on Saturday night.

HISTORY OF ULTIMATE BEACH BOWL TOURNAMENT

The 1991 Ultimate Beach Bowl is the fourth consecutive Beach Bowl to be staged by the Ultimate and Disc Association of the Palm Beaches under the direction of Tim Finan. From its early beginnings in 1988 when a small group of local Ultimate players came up with the idea of a spring tournament in Palm Beach County, it has grown to one of the best and largest tournaments in the country. The 1988 event was held at Santaluces High School in Lantana and was played by 16 teams, mostly from Florida. Miami won that first Beach Bowl. In 1989 the Beach Bowl was moved to the Palm Beach Polo and Country Club and grew to 16 men's teams attracting many more from other areas of the country. Vicious Cycle was the champion in 1989. Teams soon came to appreciate the quality, not only of the Polo Club facilities, but the tournament itself. In 1990, a cash purse of \$3,000 was offered for the first time and the UDA was proud to attract 40 top men's and women's teams nationwide. New York Ultimate won the men's division. It was the first time a women's division played being won by Lady Godiva.

In 1991, play is being divided into three evenly matched divisions, two men's and one women's, giving competitors a more even opportunity to qualify for cash awards. The purse in 1991 will be a minimum of 70% of the total entry and should exceed \$4,000. There will be 29 teams, many 1990 UPA Regional and National qualifiers.

For the first time, the two top teams from the Men's A Division will advance to the new Cuervo Gold Series Tournament in Atlanta, which is tentatively slated for Labor Day weekend.

SPIRIT OF THE GAME

Demanding athletic competition, such as that found in an Ultimate game, has a positive influence on a person's physical, mental and social development. But, what sets Ultimate apart from all other sports is the priority it places on sportsmanship - the game is characterized by its high regard for mutual respect among players and an absence of referees. The introduction to the Rules of the Game clearly defines this principle, which is referred to as the "Spirit of the Game": Ultimate has traditionally relied upon spirit of sportsmanship which places the responsibility for fair play on the player himself/herself. Highly competitive play is encouraged but never at the expense of the bond of mutual respect between players, adherence to agreed-upon rules of the game, or the basic joy of play. Protection of these vital elements serves to eliminate adverse conduct from the Ultimate field. Such actions as taunting of opposing players, dangerous aggression, intentional fouling, or other "win-at-all-costs" behavior are contrary to the spirit of the game and must be avoided by all players.

ULTIMATE FRISBEE

Ultimate is a fast moving field sport played with a Frisbee disc. The action of the game combines the passing and scoring of football, the cutting and guarding of basketball and the non-stop field movement of soccer. Because Ultimate is a team sport in which each player must act as quarterback, receiver and defender, a large number of participants can be actively involved throughout the course of play.

Ultimate is played on a field similar to a football field, with 25-year endzones at each end of a field that is 70 yards long by 40 yards wide. Two seven-person teams are on the field at once, with substitutions allowed only between goals.

The object of the game is to pass the disc from teammate to teammate until a pass is caught in the opponent's endzone. Running with the disc is not allowed: upon catching a pass, the player must stop running and establish a pivot foot before attempting the next pass. In the meantime, potential receivers are cutting towards and away from the player with the disc, often running established plays or patterns. The disc may be thrown in any direction and there is no offsides. The thrower must throw the disc within ten seconds.
