WELCOME !!!

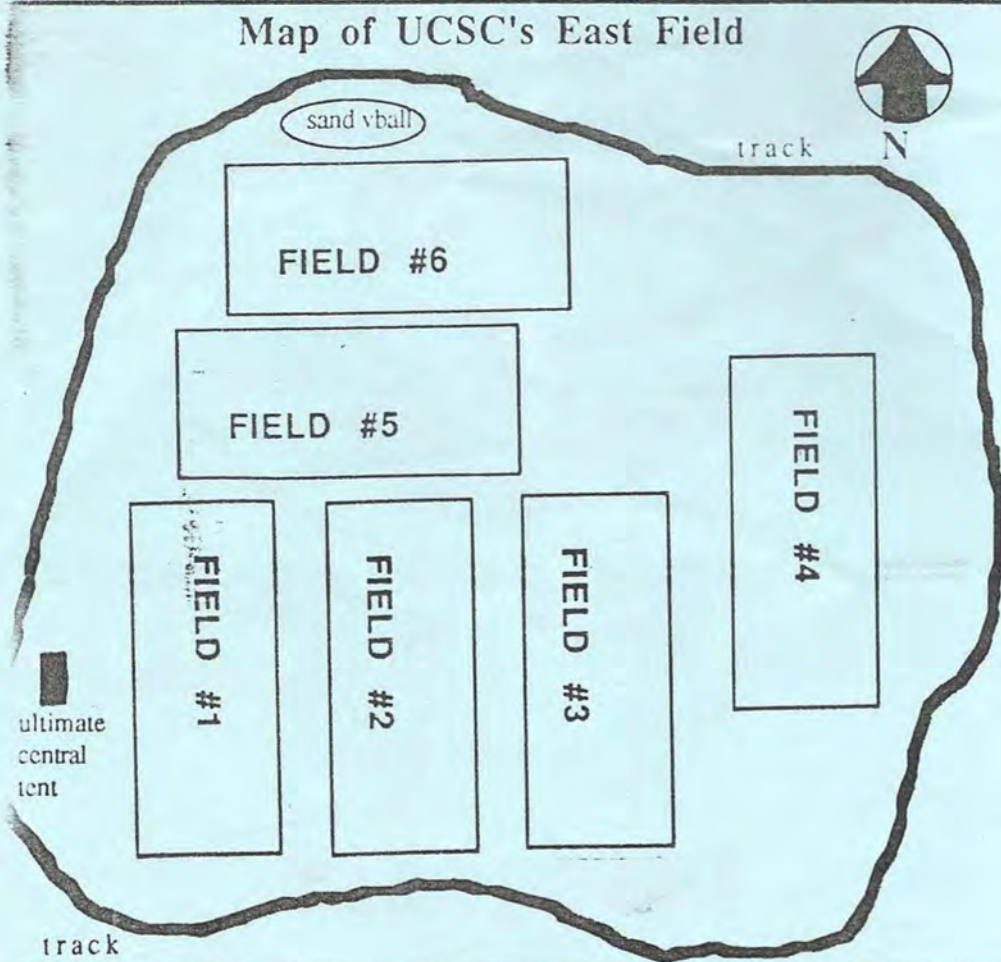
