### To our spectators

Ultimate is a non-contact sport played by two seven-player teams. The object of the game is to score goals by throwing a pass to a teammate in the goal you are attacking. The disc may only be moved by passing, as the thrower is not allowed to run with the disc once s/he has established a pivot foot (much like basketball). Anytime a pass is incomplete (dropped, knocked down, intercepted or thrown out-of-bounds) a turnover occurs; offense becomes defense and direction of play reverses. "Ultimate has traditionally relied upon a spirit of sportsmanship which places the responsibility for fair play on the player him/herself. Highly competitive play is encouraged, but never at the expense of the bond of mutual respect between players, adherence to the agreed upon rules, or the basic joy of play. Protection of these vital elements serves to eliminate adverse conduct from the Ultimate field. Such actions as taunting opposing players, dangerous aggression, intentional fouling, or other 'win-at-all-cost' behavior are contrary to the spirit of the game and must be avoided by all players".

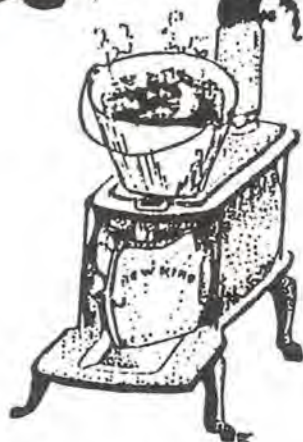

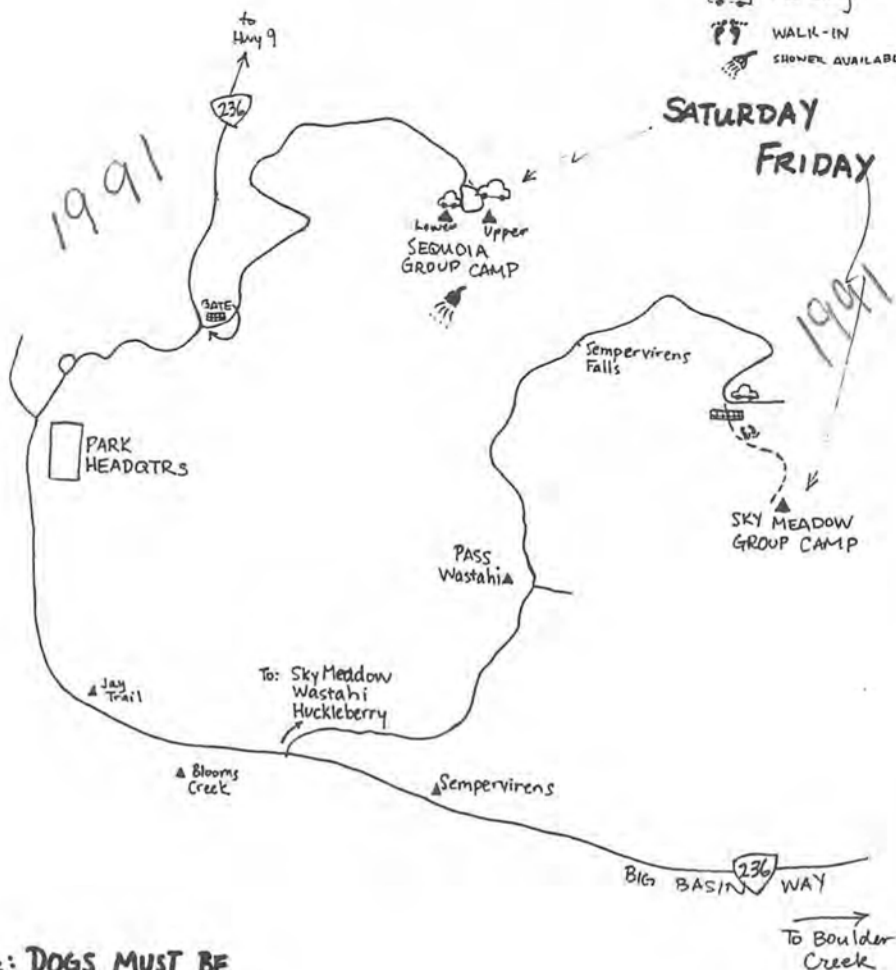
# MAP TO CAMPGROUNDS IN BIG BASIN

Since the Hats, Hops & Hucks tournament is a hat tournament (participants required to wear hats), I assume that goals can only be scored by someone wearing a hat. What happens if a goal is made in the endzone by an offensive player who is not wearing a hat? I can suggest three alternatives:

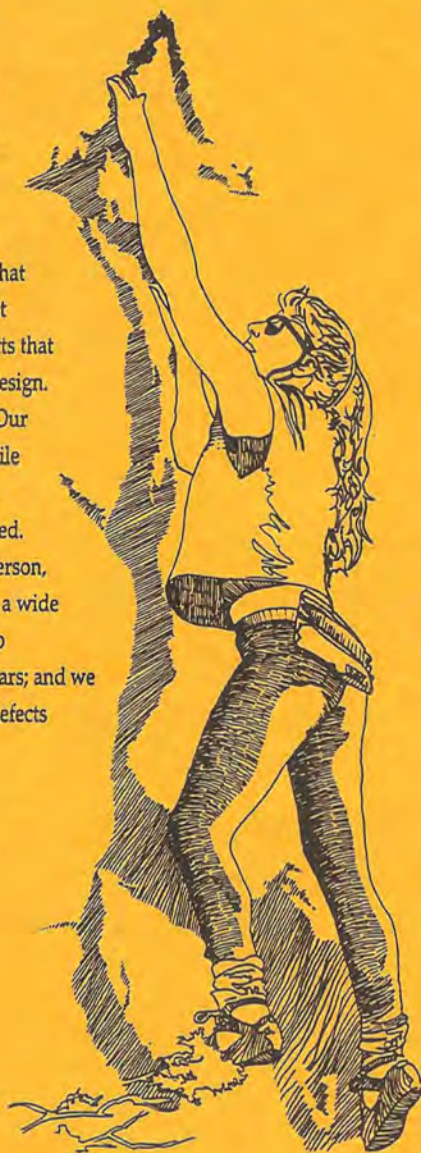

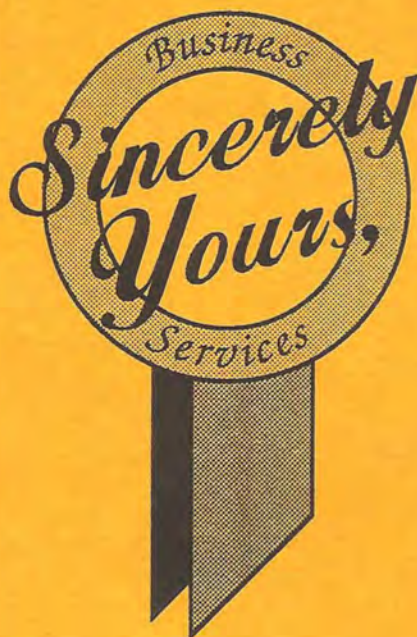
