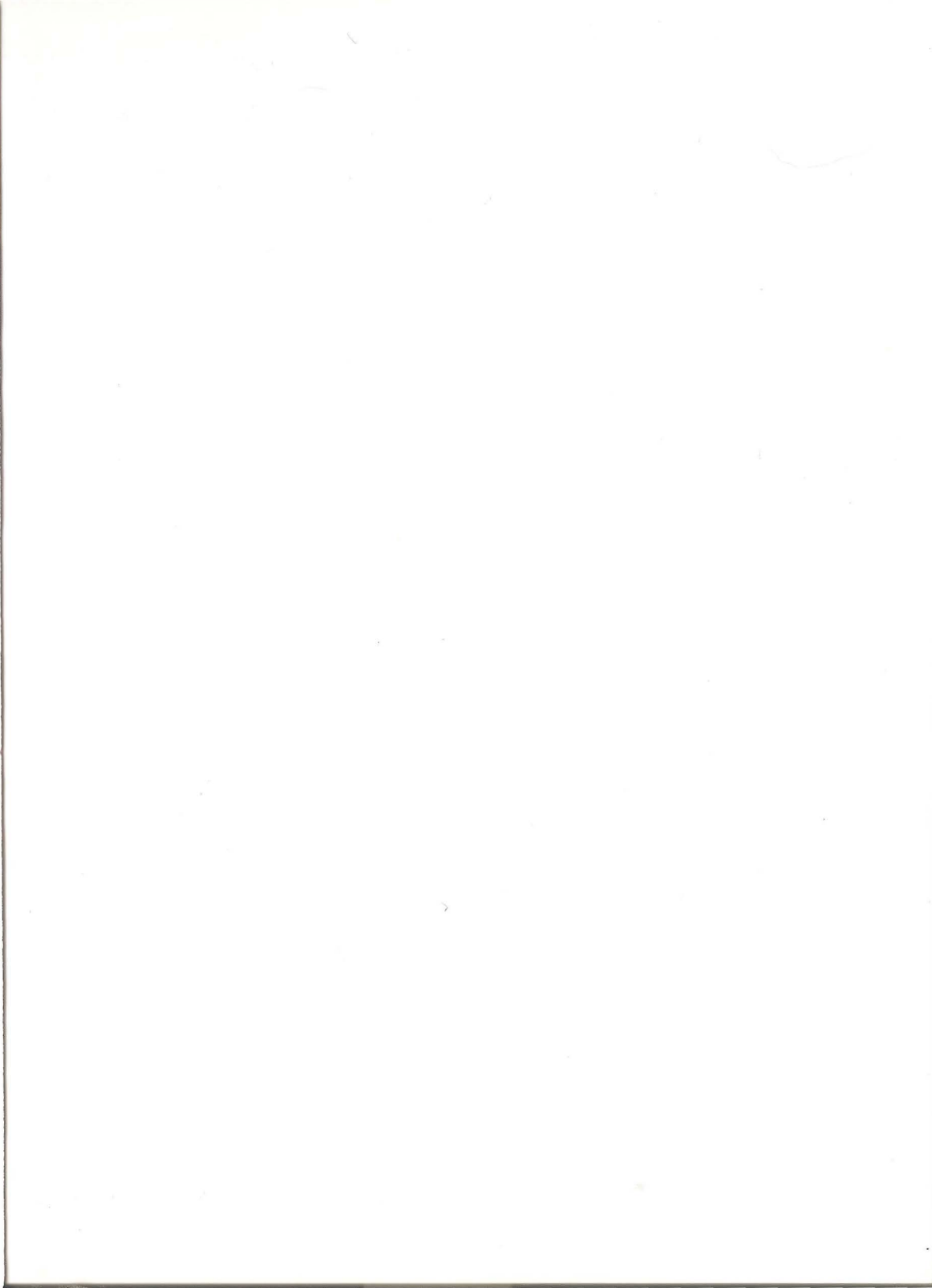

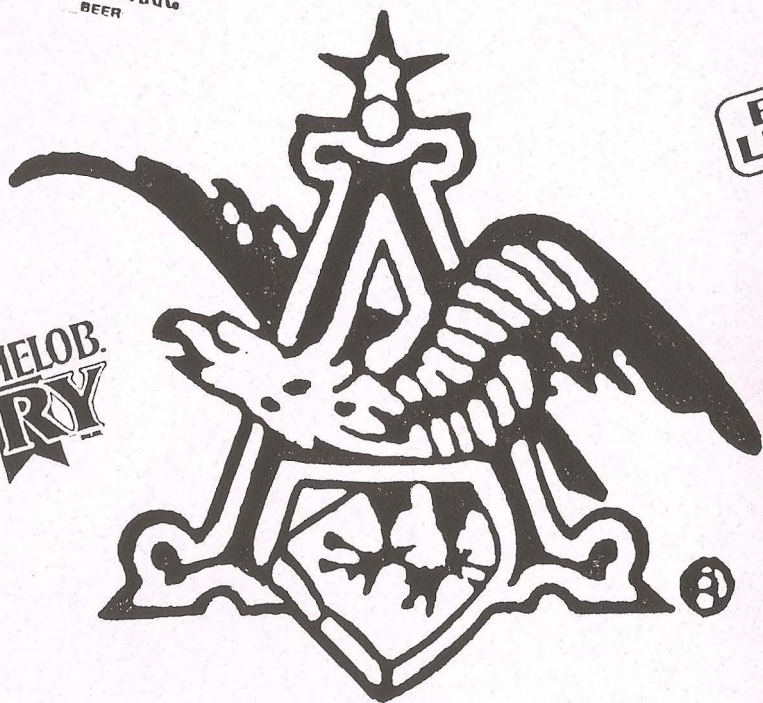

KAIMANA KLASSIK A SHORT HISTORY

Once upon a time, two men said simultaneously, "let's have an Ultimate tournament in Hawaii." Those men were Ken Gayley and Charles Shaeffer, the year was 1988, and at that moment, the tournament named Kaimana Klassik was born.

Kaimana Klassik I, played at Kaiser High School, fielded six teams, including two who would become five time returnees, Palo Alto and Cal Tech. Oahu's own Hulaguns won the first tournament defeating the veteran Cal Berkeley Bears.

The next two Klassiks, held at Kapiolani Park, were also planned and produced by Ken and Charles. The '89 tourney began as a soggy affair with rain and cloudy skies creating a bold outline of Diamond Head. Fortunately, the heat generated by Oriental Love Ring at the Falls of Clyde party Saturday night cleared the skies and perfect Hawaiian weather on Sunday spurred the Hulaguns to their second Klassik championship.

Unfortunately, the rains returned for the 1990 Klassik and didn't clear until the final points were played on Sunday. The Gang of Haolies, runners-up in '89, won their first Klassik championship by arranging undefeated Stanford's plane reservations. Kaimana III saw its first women's competition with Oahu's Mother Huckers beating the Stanford Cardinals in a muddy but exciting game.

Kaimana Klassik IV moved to its current location, the beautiful grounds of the Honolulu Polo Club, in Waimanalo. A kommittee formed to replace Ken and Charley as organizers. The primary goal in ousting the duo was to reduce the likelihood of rain. Actually, we finally realized that to host a top quality national invitational tournament HULA would need more than the dedicated efforts of those two people. Besides, Ken and Charles had earned the right to enjoy a stress-free Kaimana Klassik. Luckily, Ultimate Hawaii is blessed with many willing and talented volunteers.

Under crystal clear Hawaiian skies, the field of eight men's and four women's teams competed for the 1991 Kaimana Klassik Tiki. In one of the classic confrontations in Ultimate history, Maui's Bird of Paradise defeated the Ultimate Wahines for the Women's Championship. In the men's competition, the Gang of Haolies dominated and once again beat the Hulaguns to earn their second Klassik championship.
