

East Lansing, Michigan May 24 & 25, 1986

Welcome to East Lansing and the Centrals. If it is your first year here we hope you enjoy it as much as we do. If you have been here before we hope this year's tourney out does them all.

We have more teams this year than ever, 16 men's teams and eight women's. Washington DC, a finalist last year, is back for the fourth straight year and Windy City will be back to defend their crown for the Fifth consecutive year. New York will be represented for the first time since the inaugural tourney. On the women's side the Fisheads will also be looking for their fifth straight tournement victory.

We all hope that the frisbee and fun in East Lansing on Memorial Day Weekend turns out to be a great experience for everyone.

ULTIMATE: THE SPORT

Ultimate is a fast-moving sport, where the wind becomes another player, and people are constantly churning and diving after a piece of plastic.

Ultimate started in 1967 at Columbia High School in Maplewood, New Jersey. A group of students used a parking lot as a field and invented a new sport, what was later to become known as Ultimate Frisbee.

The name was shortened to Ultimate because of a trademark infringement with Whamo and the sport grew to be nationwide, and ultimately worldwide. It is played on a 70 X 40 yard field, with 25 yard end zones. Games are played to points, and goals are scored by completing a pass to a teammate in the end Zone.

A point is started with a downfield throw-off, or pull as it is called by players, from one team to another. The player who catches the disc must stop, establish a pivot foot, and throw a pass before the defender reaches a count of ten. If the defender reaches ten before the pass is thrown, or is the pass is intercepted, incomplete, ot out of bounds, the result is a turnover and the posession of the disc is reversed. This process is repeated with every completed pass. The result is a dynamic, free-flowing game, with olts of exciting dives and catches.






MENS TEAMS



WOMENS TEAMS


- CLUB MICH-(AnnArbor,MI) Forming a reunion team of experienced players, these women are psyched to play and have fun. Welcome back!






