Rules of the Field

- Absolutely no alcohol or illegal drugs may be brought onto the campus fields.
- Dogs and glass containers are not allowed on the fields. Coolers and plastic containers are acceptable.
- Bicycle riding on the fields is also unacceptable.
- Lurid and offensive behavior is intolerable. So, please keep a tight lip and the P off the field.
- Littering on these luscious fields cannot be forgiven. So, please put your trash in the correct receptacle.

Those who choose not to follow these simple rules may be asked to leave the premises. If they refuse and are a member of a team, the team may forfeit their most current game. The organizing staff of the tournament did not develop these rules, but handed down by the University of Texas who graciously provided these wonderful fields.



Simplified Rules of the Game

For those who are new to the sport of Ultimate here are some basic explanations of the game to help you follow along. Play begins with a group of seven players from each team standing behind its goal line. To start the game, one team throws in the direction of the opposing team, similar to a kick off in football. The receiving team must try to move the disc up the field using a series of passes. Each time a player catches the disc they must stop in their tracks and throw the disc to a teammate. They must throw the disc to a teammate within ten seconds or be called for a stalling foul. If a stalling foul is called, play is stopped and the disc is then turned over to the opposing team.

To score a point, the receiving team must complete a pass to a player positioned behind the opponent's goal line. The defending team is awarded the disc following a score, an incomplete pass, stalling foul, or an interception. The first team to score the designated points wins the game.

Game Times

All Game Times: Start times are approximate and subject to change.


Saturday: Initial games will start at 10:00 a.m. with new games starting approximately every 90 minutes.

Sunday: Women's Final start at 11:30 a.m. on field one.


Sunday: Men's Semi-final starts at 10:00 a.m. see main board for field location and teams. Men's Final will start at approximately 4:00 p.m. on field one.




